

CAMPSITE INTERNAL RULES

- 1. Access to and use of the campsite facilities is exclusive to registered guests. External visitors are allowed with prior reservation and subject to availability. Visitors must present identification and pay the corresponding fee. Overnight stays without prior registration are not permitted.
- 2. Minors under the age of 16 are not allowed to enter unless accompanied by an adult.
- 3. Wearing the identification wristband is mandatory throughout the stay at the campsite. This wristband is personal and non-transferable. Similarly, the control sticker must be placed in a visible spot on the vehicle (windshield for cars and the front for motorcycles).
- 4. The campsite day ends at 11:00 a.m. for bungalows and at 12:00 p.m. for pitches. Late check-outs will incur an additional cost.
- 5. Installing items not intended for temporary campsite use, such as flooring, fences, ropes, tarps, sinks, or appliances that may affect the campsite's image, is prohibited.
- 6. The campsite is not responsible for theft, damage, or loss of guests' belongings, nor for damages caused by fires, weather conditions, or other events beyond its control.
- 7. To avoid disturbing other guests, the volume of devices such as TVs and radios must be kept low. Rest hours are from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and from 10:00 p.m. to midnight. Quiet hours are from midnight to 8:00 a.m. During this time, noise or use of devices that may disturb others is prohibited. Vehicle movement is not allowed, except in authorized emergencies. If you plan to leave before 8:00 a.m. or arrive after midnight, you must park your vehicle outside the campsite.
- 8. The maximum speed limit is 5 km/h. The use of electric scooters, mini-motorcycles, or quads within the premises is not allowed. Cyclists must obey traffic signals and rules. Dangerous or competitive cycling is prohibited, and all motor vehicles must be registered.
- 9. Charging electric vehicles (cars, bicycles, scooters, etc.) at accommodations or pitches is prohibited. Any damage resulting from this practice will be the sole responsibility of the guest.
- 10. We provide two playground areas for children aged 4 to 14. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. Smoking, eating, playing football, or riding scooters and/or bicycles is prohibited in these areas.
- 11. The mini club is for children aged 4 to 12. It is not a daycare. Parents or guardians must be reachable at all times.



- 12. To avoid disturbing other campers, games and sports must be carried out in designated areas. Court schedules or reservations can be checked at reception.
- 13. Use of the swimming pool and slides is only allowed during the established hours. Showering before entering the pool is mandatory. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. Pool access must be safe: use the stairs, and jumping from the edges is prohibited. Swimming in inappropriate clothing (shirts, pants, shoes, snorkel gear, etc.) is not allowed, nor is smoking, bringing animals, or eating. Beverages may only be consumed in plastic containers or cans. Glass is strictly prohibited. Any inappropriate behaviour will result in immediate expulsion from the area. The campsite ensures the maintenance of the pools and their facilities. We appreciate guests reporting any malfunction, breakage, or deficiency to reception. Arm bands or swim bubbles are allowed for children who cannot swim. Inflatable floats are not allowed. In case of inclement weather or storms, guests must leave the pools. Individuals with contagious infections or diseases are not permitted to access the swimming areas.
- 14. Wearing appropriate footwear and maintaining decent attire is mandatory in the sanitary facilities. Smoking, eating, or drinking inside the bathrooms, as well as bringing animals, is prohibited. Please follow the instructions of the cleaning staff.
- 15. Barbecues are allowed as long as a safe distance from facilities is maintained. Open fires on the ground are not allowed, and only charcoal can be used.
- 16. The campsite practices selective waste collection. Please help us recycle and protect the environment by using the appropriate containers to dispose of trash.
- 17. Individuals with contagious diseases are not allowed to access communal swimming areas.
- 18. Any non-compliance of the campsite's internal regulations or rules of coexistence may result in expulsion without a refund.
